Who we are

The Clarkston Youth Baseball Organization, the Riverdawgs, is an organization dedicated to providing area youth the opportunity to participate in the sport of baseball at the highest amateur level. We are dedicated to training the players and coaches involved in the organization in the fundamental aspects of the game and providing the highest level of competition possible. The emphasis of the organization is on the "team" and on the development of baseball and leadership skills in all of our players and coaches.

The Riverdawgs are planning to have 9 teams during the 2026 season starting at 8U all the way through 18U.

Tryouts

Tryouts are conducted in late June and early July each year for the subsequent season. There is a minimum of 2 tryout dates each year. Potential players are required to attend a minimum of 1 tryout however players are encouraged to attend all tryouts.

All potential players will be notified of the tryout results no later than 8/1/2025

Off Season Training

With the exception of our 15U through 19U teams, our off-season training begins in late November to early January and varies by team. Off Season training is conducted at different facilities depending on the purpose of the instruction.

Full workout - Oakland Yard - Each team will have a minimum of 1 day per week using this facility.

Hitting, Pitching, Catching - Riverdawg facility in Waterford, MI – Teams can use this facility as often as want. Workouts are scheduled 1 week in advance

Hitting, Pitching, Catching - in Bloomfield Hills, MIWaterford, MI – Teams can use this facility 1 time a week, instructors are provided as part of this facility.

Speed and Agility - All Riverdawg Team may have access to professional speed and agility training provided by local professionals.

Player and Coach Development

Professional instructors are provided for 8U to 13U team once per week during off season training in the area of hitting, pitching and catching. Riverdawg instructors are also available to each Riverdawg player at an additional cost for private instruction.

Practice and Game Facilities

The Riverdawgs have their own field which is used by the Riverdawg 14U - 18U teams for practice, games, and tournaments. This facility is located at 4819 Mary Sue Clarkston, MI.





League Games and Tournaments

Most of our teams participate in the North Oakland Baseball Federation (NOBF) and in various tournaments throughout the year. In total most teams will play between 30 and 40 games during the season. There are approximately 20 league games and 4 to 6 tournaments during the season. Some of the tournaments may be out of town. Tournament and league games usually start during the month of April and conclude during the month of July.

Uniforms

Al players are provided with complete uniforms for the season which includes: 2 jerseys, 2 pair of pants, , practice jersey, hat, helmet, belt, warmup hoodie, and equipment bag.

Fees

The fee for the 2026 season is:

8U to 13U - \$2,300

14U TO 19U - \$2,200

The fee covers all expenses for the 2026 season including; winter practices, professional instruction by our instructors, uniforms, team equipment, tournament fees, league fees, etc. <u>You will not be asked for</u> any additional monies during the 2026 season. The organization may choose to do 1 or more fundraising activities during the year in which families are expected to participate.

Fees are paid in 2 installments. The first installment is due on September 30th and the second installment is due on January 31st
